A distinguished scholar who has been published internationally, she is a fellow of the Congregational Foundation for Theological Studies. She will draw on scripture and history to address the spiritualized symbols in Revelation that address the problem of evil, including numbers and even colors used by the book's creator. "Please join us," Rev. Rhinesmith says, "as we engage the vibrant imagination and skillful storytelling of the author of Revelation, and unlock some of its powerful mysteries."
